

APPLICATION FOR ENROLMENT

An *Application for Enrolment* form must be completed in order to register a student, together with an administration fee of \$110.00 inc GST. This fee is non-refundable and does not guarantee enrolment. It will place you on the mailing list for *Newman Now* and other enrolment information.

TUITION FEES 2009

Fees for **Years K to 11** are billed four times per year at the commencement of each term. Fees for **Year 12** are billed three times per year at the commencement of term 1, 2 & 3.

(* Note, Kindy extra day does not receive Government Funding and full fees apply.)

The Primary Fees include College Year Book and Student Accident Insurance. Camps, Sacramental programmes, Spelling Resources, Swimming and other payments to third parties will be charged separately on the term account.

The Secondary Fees include College Year Book; College Diary; Guild Fees and Student Accident Insurance. A basic Excursion Fee is also included. Year 7, Year 8 and Year 11 Camp, and Year 12 Retreat, are charged separately. Other charges may be billed for ONSITE, JBM Program, subject textbooks, optional camps, Award evenings, printing levy, padlock and fees paid by the College on behalf of students to third parties.

MUSIC TUITION

The fee for (optional) instrumental music tuition will be charged on the term account and is payable in advance. One term's notice must be given to withdraw lessons. Contact the Head of Music for further details.

CAPITAL LEVY

A compulsory Capital Levy of **\$456** per annum is charged per family. The funds are used to contribute to the debt servicing of the College's existing building and capital loans, as well as providing specific funds for new capital improvements. The P&F Levy previously charged as a separate bill to Primary families is now encompassed within the Capital Levy charge. The Primary P&F Committee will still manage their proportion of the Levy.

AIR-CONDITIONING APPEAL

The College launched an appeal in 2006 in order to raise \$350,000 to complete the air-conditioning of all classrooms throughout the school. An opportunity to donate is provided on the bottom of each Term Account. Together with the proceeds of the Newman Arts Festival, over \$280,000 has been raised to date. S Block is planned for air-conditioning in 2009.

All donations are fully tax-deductible.

FAMILY CONCESSION

The following discount applies to the Tuition Fees (the sibling discount does not apply if the child is in Kindergarten):

- First & Second Child - Full Fees
- Third Child - 15% discount off total Tuition Fees
- Fourth Child - 40% discount off total Tuition Fees
- Fifth Child - 60% discount off total Tuition Fees

FINANCIAL DIFFICULTY

Should payment at any time present a difficulty, please immediately contact the College Finance Officer or the Business Manager to make alternative arrangements. An *Application for Financial Assistance* form may need to be completed to assess the assistance that is available.

HEALTH CARE CARD FEE DISCOUNT SCHEME

The Catholic Education Office has introduced a fee discount scheme for holders of a Health Care Card and certain Pensioner Concession Cards. For full eligibility details and an application form, contact the College accounts office.

SECONDARY ASSISTANCE SCHEME

The State Education Department offers a Secondary Assistance Scheme for the holders of a Centrelink Health Care Card, Pensioner Concession Card or Veteran Affairs Pensioner concession card. Application forms are available from the accounts office, and some conditions do apply.

INSURANCE

The College has a Student Accident Insurance Policy covering all students 24 hours per day for limited lump sum benefits. Parents are advised to have comprehensive private health insurance in addition.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

It is a condition of enrolment that one full term's notice of withdrawal of a student is given in writing. In the event that such notice is not given, a full term's fee may apply.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

All fees are payable within 14 days of the account being rendered, unless satisfactory arrangements or progressive payments by Direct Debit are approved by the accounts office.
